



Held in Bendigo on August 16–17, Hard Yards: Children Who Challenge is a one–day conference, repeated over two days, to help teachers, health and community workers, advocates and families learn new skills to support children living with challenges, such as a learning impairment, trauma, homelessness or bullying, achieve their full potential. To help us capture what it's like for young people facing obstacles, we're inviting children and teens from across Victoria to design an original artwork that can be used in the poster and promotional material for the conference. Winners in each category will receive a \$500 prize.

Categories

Junior: 5-13 years | Senior: 14-18 years

Size

A4 (210mm × 297mm)

Medium

Artwork may be created in any medium, including digital, oil, acrylic, pencil, ink, mixed medium or photography

Originality

All artworks must be your own work and not copied from another source

Description

What's your artwork about? Describe your inspiration in 100 words or less

Theme

What does putting in the 'hard yards' look like to you?
This could be at school or when learning new skills, hanging out with friends or classmates, facing challenges like trauma, bullying or homelessness, living with a disability, such as autism spectrum disorder, or about working hard to achieve something special.
